Subject: Transition to Remote Learning in Light of the Current Situation

Dear Parents,
Greetings!

In view of the ongoing crisis in the region and in alignment with safety directives and the guidance from the Ministry of Education, Kingdom of Bahrain, our school will be transitioning to **remote learning (Online Classes)** until further notice. The well-being of our students, staff, and families remains our highest priority, and this adjustment ensures continuity of education while safeguarding our community.

Key Points:

- **Classes Begin:**
Std X & XII – 6th April 2026 (**online**)
Std I to IX & XI – 8th April 2026 (**online**)
- **Mode of Delivery:** Online platforms already familiar to students (Zoom Platforms)
- **Daily Schedule:** Classes will follow a modified timetable to balance academic rigor with student well-being.
- **Assessments:** Teachers will provide clear guidance on assignments, projects, and evaluations adapted for online learning.
- **Support:** Parents are encouraged to help children maintain routines and provide a quiet study space at home. Our staff will remain available for queries and technical assistance. We kindly request the parents to ensure that students refrain from engaging in inappropriate online activities, such as posting memes, images, or content that may hurt the sentiments of any individual, country, faith, or religion. Please help them understand the seriousness and implications of such actions, as the consequences may be far-reaching, and the school may not be able to intervene in such matters.

Technical Guidelines for Students (Online Classes via Zoom)

To ensure smooth and effective online learning, students are required to follow the guidelines given below:

1. Email ID Creation

- Students of Classes **VI to XII** are required to create an email ID in the prescribed format and submit it to their respective class teachers on or before **4th April 2026**.
Email format: nameclassdivisionadmissionnumber
Example: sam5a40090@gmail.com
- Students of classes I to V can use their parent's email ID and submit to their respective class teacher.

2. **Login Credentials**

All students must log in using their **registered email ID**, which has been submitted to the class teacher.

3. **Profile Details**

The Zoom profile picture should be a **photograph of the student in school uniform**, and the display name must match the school attendance records.

Example: Sam Melban 5A 40090

4. **Technical Readiness**

Please ensure that your device (laptop/mobile/tablet) and internet connection are functioning properly before the start of each class.

5. **Uniform and Classroom Etiquette**

Students are required to attend classes in proper school uniform.

- The camera must remain **ON** for attendance verification.
- The microphone should remain muted unless instructed by the teacher.

6. **Confidentiality of Access**

Students must not share the Zoom meeting ID or password with anyone under any circumstances.

7. **Following Instructions**

Students are expected to follow all instructions given by the teacher and maintain discipline throughout the session.

8. **Online Conduct and Discipline**

Any disruption of the class through unnecessary audio/video sharing or inappropriate behavior will be dealt with strictly, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Ministry of Education, Kingdom of Bahrain, and the Cyber Security Laws of Bahrain.

9. **Attendance Procedure**

Attendance will be recorded manually at the beginning of the class and verified through electronic attendance records at the end of the session.

10. **Mandatory Attendance**

Topics covered during online classes will not be repeated in offline sessions. Therefore, regular attendance is mandatory.


11. **Recording of Sessions**
