We thank you for choosing our School for admitting your child. Keeping in mind your hopes and aspirations. We would like to give you a few glimpses of our institution.

Name: The New Indian School, a landmark in education, is a Senior Secondary School and Junior College, affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

Location: The School is located in a sprawling campus at Isa Town, close to the GDN office (Bldg.129, Block 941, Road 4101,(East Riffa).

History of the School: The establishment of the institution in 1990 was the result of the combined efforts of a team of enthusiasts, dedicated to the cause of education. The team, comprising of responsible people, represents a cross section of the Indian Community. The mission of the School is to propagate good education in a cosmopolitan society, retaining the cultural heritage of India.

Our Motto: The motto of the School “In Pursuit of Excellence” highlights the quality of education imparted to students, to enable them to excel in every facet of life and grow up into disciplined and responsible citizens of the community.

Teaching Fraternity: The School has a band of highly qualified, experienced and trained teachers, who are committed to the cause of education.

The Curriculum: The school follows the syllabus prescribed by the CBSE, Delhi. It aims at the attainment of the highest order of academic excellence from Kindergarten to Class XII. Hindi, Arabic, French, Malayalam and Tamil are offered as second/third language from Classes I to X. At the Plus Two level, Science and Commerce streams are offered.

The School prepares students for the following Public Examinations.

1) All India Secondary School Examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, at the end of Class X.

2) All India Senior School Certificate Examination conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, at the end of Class XII.

The School offers ample opportunities to bring out the innate talent of the child through multifarious activities like Music, Dance, Art & Craft, Band and Public Speaking.

Academic Year: The Academic year is divided into three Terms.

I Term - April to June

II Term - September to December

III Term - January to March.

Open House : Regular Parent Teacher meetings are arranged to discuss the progress of the wards and ensure good performance.

Infrastructure : The School has an ideal ambiance with the following infrastructure.

- Airy, spacious and well-furnished classrooms.
- Well-equipped Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology Laboratories.
- State of the Art Computer laboratory.
- A Multi – purpose Hall.
- Audio Visual Room.

- Facility for indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, Caroms, Badminton etc. and vast playgrounds for Cricket, Football and Basketball.
- Exclusive playfield and activity room for the KG Section.
- Comprehensive programme for Fine Arts, Music, Dance and Public Speaking.
- A well-equipped Library and Reading Room.
- Air Conditioned Transport facilities.
- A well maintained School Canteen.

Fees : The School adopts a very reasonable Fee Structure.

Admission Criteria: Admission is open to all Indians. Admission to Nationalities is subject to available of seats. Children are directly admitted to LKG and for other classes admission is given on the basis of an Entrance Test and the previous qualifying records.

Age Requirement : The child should have completed 3 years 6 months of age by 31st March, for admission into Lower KG and this age criteria is proportionately applicable to children seeking admission to other classes.

Supply of Text Books: Parents should buy Text Books & Note books only from the school.
